

Mourning the Loss of Warren G. Hunt

We are saddened to note the Oct. 18 death of Warren G. Hunt, one of the founding members of Lahey Clinic Northshore, Peabody, known today as Lahey Medical Center, Peabody.

Mr. Hunt's tenure at Lahey spanned 35 years, beginning when the hospital was located in Boston. He helped to transform and relocate the hospital to its then-new location on Mall Road in Burlington. After years of managing day-to-day operations and expansions in Burlington, Mr. Hunt was assigned to his most-recognized achievement for the organization: creating and developing Lahey Clinic Northshore, Peabody.

Mr. Hunt retired in 2004 as Senior Vice President of the Lahey Clinic Organization after years of managing operations and expansions at the Peabody location. His contribution to Lahey's success was recognized when he was named a member of the Emeritus Staff.
